Departure Point

We are leaving from **Phasels Wood Campsite please meet in the car park off the A41** please be there at <u>5.45pm</u>, the coach leaves at 6.00pm if you are not there your team will be short and may be disqualified.

Phasels Wood Activity Centre is just 3 miles form Junction 20 of the M25 towards Hemel Hempstead on the A41. The entrance is in the second lay-by from the M25 roundabout. There is a sign just before the lay-by: 'Scout Camp access via lay-by'.

You must wear full uniform from waist upwards (suggest you wear full uniform as scout trousers will meet HPA spec if there is any dispute over kit at kit check) also suggest you wear your walking boots as you may be walking to base campsite and it could be very muddy.

We will have a quick stop at the services on the way up but it's probably best to have something to eat before you leave.

Put your waterproof and torch where you can find them quickly ie on the coach with you as you will need them as soon as we arrive at base camp. Pack your tent so you can get it up quickly.

Kit

Pack all you kit in your rucksack ready for Saturday Morning double check that you have everything. Tag your bag with a label that states St Albans Explorers and your name. You can have a very small bag to take on the coach and to put your uniform etc in that you do not take on the hill, also maybe trainers for the journey home. Also don't forget mug and spoon to eat and drink.

If you have queries with regards packing your rucksack please ask. You should not have anything hanging from the outside of your bag.

Arrive at Campsite

When we arrive we have a lot of kit to move to the campsite **not just your own please help.** There is not time to stand around so if you find yourself with nothing to do think about what needs to be done and get on with it.

Teamwork is the key with everyone mucking in not mucking about! Friday night Jobs list. Put up tents, stow kit, fill water carrier, set up stove/kitchen go to bed.
